Basics

- Played with four players
- Played with 16 tiles in-hand, 17th tile completes a hand
- Standard combination includes five sets of three in a sequence (chow) or three of a kind (pung) or four of a kind (kong) and a pair
- Honors are any combination of Winds and Dragons
- Chows can only be claimed from player on your left
- Pungs and kongs can be claimed from any discard
- Played with Dots, Bams, Cracks and Flowers (Winds, Dragons, Flowers and Seasons)
- Payment: discarder pays hand-value; self-drawn win, all pay hand-value

Setup

- All build walls then winner throws the dice to determine the next dealer
- The dealer then throws the dice and selects any wall but their own and counts that number from right to left then splits the wall
- The dealer takes four stacks of two, the player to the right takes four stacks of two and so on until all players have 16 tiles; the dealer takes one more tile
- Everyone exposes Flower and replaces them from the end of the wall until all have been replaced
- After Flowers have been replaced, the dealer throws dice, counts that number right to left from the end of the wall then flips the tile to expose the wild card
